May I suggest that when any guest is said to represent any non-profit group that he or she be asked who finances the group. This would surely assist the listener in evaluating his or her statements.

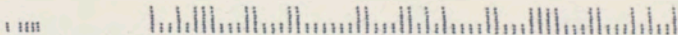
