I do appreciate that what was happening in this country was very important, but every time I switched to C Span to see what was going on between 6.30p.m. and 11p.m., the screen was filled for the most part with absolutely nothing of any relevance. I feel very much that you could have broadcast the British Election and just cut to the USA when anything of import was announced. I am very dissatisfied.

I would appreciate receiving your comments, especially as to why, at no time did I see any information printed on the screen to explain to the viewer why you were not broadcasting from Britain.
