6. MR. QUAYLE DID NOT RESPOND TO SENATOR GORE'S (VICE PRESIDENTIAL DEBATE) QUESTION: "Can you now confirm 88-18 MISSILES, OUTRANED BUSH-GORE'S AGREEMENT, ARE STILL IN THEIR SILOS?"
7. TODAY ISRAEL AND SAUDI ARABIA ARE BETTER DEFENDED AGAINST MISSILES, THAN IS THIS COUNTRY! (Bush did NOT TAKE SENATE-GIVEN OPPORTUNITY TO BRING U.S. INTO COMPLIANCE WITH ABM TREATY - "Missile Defense Act of 1992"!.) Sponsored by Sens. Humpal, Warner, et al.
8. DESPITE DENIALS, IT HAS BEEN REAGAN-BUSH POLICY IN PAST THREE REPUBLICAN ADMINISTRATIONS TO:
1. FIND MAULADORS IN MEXICO (partly by Pentagon),
  2. PROVIDE LOAN GUARANTEES TO EMBASSIES IN D.C. (at expense of U.S. CONTRACTORS FOR S.D.I.), and
  3. ALLOW U.S. CORPORATIONS TO "FIRE" OLDER (over age-40) WORKERS WITHOUT CAUSE - UNDER CLARENCE THOMAS' E.E.O.C. CHAIRMANSHIP.
9. (FROM "8" ABOVE) IT IS STILL PRIVATE SECTOR HIRING POLICY - AIDED AND ABETTED BY REPUBLICAN ADMINISTRATIONS, SINCE 1981 - TO DISPLACE OLDER WORKERS, PERCEIVED "OVER-QUALIFIED" FOR FULL EMPLOYMENT ("TOO MUCH" FORMAL EDUCATION / "TOO MUCH" MANAGERIAL EXPERIENCE), WHILE JOBS AND FEDERAL TAX CREDITS / SUBSIDIES WENT OVERSEAS.
