I don't have any tapes etc.

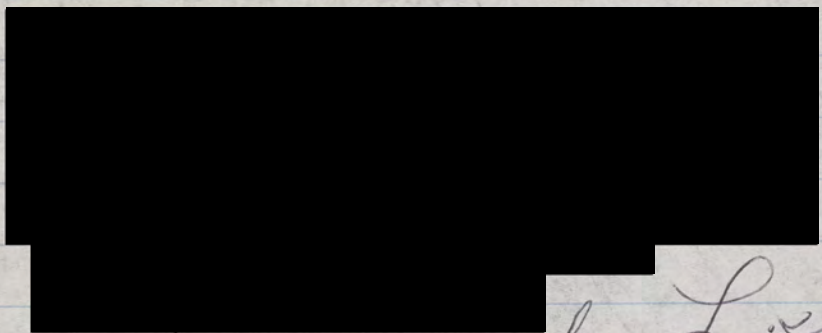
President Truman learned
