As Brian Lamb said this morning, C-SPAN viewers when deprived become a herd of very angry Rottweilers.

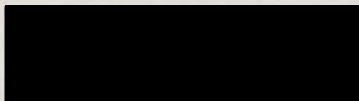
I refuse to believe that in your new line-up is no room for C-SPAN 2.
