C-SPAN'S "ELECTION '90" FEATURES DELAWARE SENATE RACE

Program Also Looks At Campaign Advertising in California

Washington, D.C., August 14 -- The Delaware Senate race between incumbent Joseph Biden (D) and challenger Jan Brady (R) will be the focus on "Election '90" this Sunday, August 19, at 12:30 PM, 9:30 PM, and 12:30 AM (ET).

The program includes interviews with the candidates discussing the Senate race as well as Sen. Biden's aborted run for the White House in 1988. Also featured will be a speech by Ms. Brady to a Republican fundraiser in Wilmington and Sen. Biden's press conference announcing his candidacy.

Sen. Biden is seeking his 4th term as Delaware senator. Ms. Brady, a prosecutor in Sussex County, Delaware, is one of seven women running for U.S. Senate seats this year.

The 90-minute program will also feature a look at the new campaign commercials airing in California as part of the governor's race between former San Francisco Mayor Diane Feinstein (D) and Sen. Pete Wilson (R). Mark Barnhill, Washington bureau chief of the Los Angeles Daily News, will be the guest.

"Election '90," C-SPAN's weekly program focusing on the 1990 elections, provides viewers with comprehensive coverage of key House, Senate, and gubernatorial races.
