O'Neill back as killer in 'Personals'

It's good to see Jennifer O'Neill in a starring role again, even if she plays your standard TV psychotic killer in a new movie for cable's USA Network.

In "Personals," airing at 9 p.m. Wednesday, O'Neill portrays a woman who selects her victims from a newspaper's personal columns, dates them at night and leaves them dead by morning.

By day, Heather Moore is a modest librarian. But come nightfall, she dons blond wig and gets decked out as a *femme fatale* who sees each victim as the guy who done her wrong. Like I said, not real original.

But when she kills a magazine reporter (Robin Thomas) doing an undercover story on "lonely women," his assistant district attorney wife (Stephanie Zimbalist as Sarah Martin) goes after her through the same newspaper ads.

The Rio de Janeiro-born O'Neill, perhaps best remembered as the young war bride in 1971's "Summer of '42," has been missing from the limelight since she accidentally shot herself at her New York home in 1982 while checking a revolver to see if it was loaded. It was.

(But in New York, just because you accidentally shoot yourself and live to tell about it doesn't mean your troubles are over. O'Neill and her husband, John Lederer, were charged with criminal possession of a handgun.)

In 1983, she starred as Lady Bobbi Rowan in the short-lived NBC

series on the perfume business, "Bare Essence," and as a secret agent (disguised as a model) in the 1984 CBS series "Cover Up."
