"A PORTRAIT OF A PRESIDENT"

With a frequency, comparable it would seem, not unlike that of Halley's Comet, there oft times emerge among peoples and governments, men of vision and integrity whom have the ability to lead and deliver their nations from the precipices of political prostitution. That political prostitution that foments political decay and national economic stagnation.

Today in our own nation's midst, from out of the dung heaps of our own nation's political decay, the decay that bring peoples and nations to the brink of destruction, there is come among us such a man! A man of great passions, passion that is equaled only by his compassion for other men and for his nation. A man of great moral strength and a giant among other men of integrity. A man of unprecedented and demonstrated domestic and international diplomacy. A man, who, despite the fervor and the magnitude of his passions is the master of his passion, with the strengths to rule his passion rather than allowing those passions to destroy his strengths or integrity. You may ask, "WHO IS THIS MAN?" . . . My answer would be, "THE MAN FROM C-SPAN, MR. BRIAN LAMB!"

Mr. Brian Lamb, in my opinion, is one of those rare men whose principal or ultimate goal, it seems to me, is not self-grandiosity, self enhancement, or self enrichment at the expense of other men's lives. He is a man who strikes me as finding his rewards in his ability to instill purpose in, or to enhance the lives of other men. Mr. Brian Lamb reminds me of another, who for a time, until his death, greatly influenced my own life. This other man was a grammar school teacher. he was also my friend. My friend once told me when I questioned him about his reasons for teaching, for he had the ability to pursue much higher goals that would enrich him more handsomely, he told me, "If by my efforts I can lead one child to find, that will lead, that child from a wasted life to a path that will become fruitful and productive, my purpose in being who or what I am will have been fulfilled and my compensation will be ever lasting!"

Mr. Brian Lamb is a man much like my friend, but unlike my friend who sought to influence the lives of children, Mr. Lamb has the ability to save a nation and it's people! It is "WE THE PEOPLE" who must seize our opportunity from this day forward until election day in November 1996 to convince Mr. Lamb that he can be the fuel that can propel our nation and our people into and even beyond the next century, that he can be the force that will renew the dreams that brought our forefathers to these shores, to the land we call, "THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA!" But if we ask, if we are to convince this man to show us our way, to lead us, then "WE THE PEOPLE" must prepare his way. In the interim, both in 1994 as well as in 1996, we must seek out other men with like or similar qualities, as our Representatives and Senators, men whom will support both his views and ours. Mr. Lamb has also had more close personal contact and has interviewed more political leaders from city and county levels all the way to The White House than anyone you can name and in doing so has come to know our government and our government's leaders so well that I doubt that any other living man would be more equipped to lead our government and our people. The same holds true in his capacity with politicians and leaders of other nations and their government, for few men have known so many so intimately. Additionally Mr. Lamb probably has a working relationship not only with representatives of the American news media but also the world's news media that probably no other man can equal. Who then I ask is better able to diagnose our nation's ills or better equipped to prescribe those actions that can heal our nation. I would challenge any politician or national leader, whether they be our own or those of another nation, who would be able to conclude that debate and come away with little more than a lamp compared to Mr. Lamb's bright beacon.

My life has encompassed many campaigns, as well as observed the incumbencies of countless numbers of politicians and leaders, from the time of President Woodrow Wilson to the present, from mayors and county supervisors to Congressmen to Presidents. With each passing election I have seen less democracy and only more and more of men entering and pursuing the course of politics whom do so, not out of patriotism and duty to their country, but as a way to increase their own grandiosity, for their feeling or need for power, or to enrich themselves at the expense of those they pretend to lead, "WE THE PEOPLE!" Where else but in The United States of America do the people pay their Senators and Representatives over \$130,000.00 per year to represent them, where the very next day after election and taking office those same Senators spend the greater part of their time with


efforts to raise money and campaigning for reelection. Where else . . . but in The United States of America do the Senators and Representatives of the people who by the method of our election system are supposed to represent their constituents, are more influenced by the gifts, moneys, and contributions of special interest groups, political action groups, corporations and other like groups from other states and other nations or governments than by the constituency by whom they are elected. In my way of reasoning, great numbers of our leaders are worse than philanderers and prostitutes, those that choose this path are they any less dishonorable than pimps and whores, are they any less dishonorable than the peddlers who sell dope to our children, are they any less corruptable? Even those whom seek and gain office, those who enter into serving our people with honor, soon learn if they are to retain office must make the choice to leave office and keep their self respect, or join ranks with the corrupt. Very few can find the middle line in our political system.

So I don't much concern myself as to whether Mr. Lamb is Democrat or republican, abolitionist or whig, conservative, liberal, or middle of the road, what ever his politics, as long as he has the independance to think free and bring freedom back to a free people. I believe he has the ability, I pray he will find the strength.

Too long have we lived with politicians whose campaign promises become only promises and lies, who spend their great majority of time campaigning on how their opponents have failed, and how they break moral laws by cheating on their wives. or how they are draft dodgers and all the myriads of half truths. I may never vote again for I have vowed that I will vote for no candidate for any office who bad mouths his opponents. Any candidate who wants my vote will spend his time explaining to me what assets he will bring to my government I can no longer abide candidates who spend 80% of their time telling me why I should not vote for someone else, I want them to convince me why I should vote for them...

More than ever I believe Mr. Brian Lamb should become our next president, God help us if I should be wrong, but if Mr. Lamb should fail us or should not be elected it will not matter and we continue on our present path we are lost anyway.
