up to that moment. And to my astonishment, it went on for several more hours.

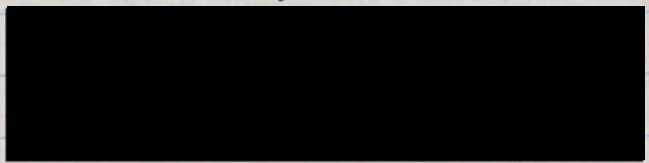
