Mr. Lewis Lapham very probably thinks he's an educated man, but education doesn't make them intelligent.

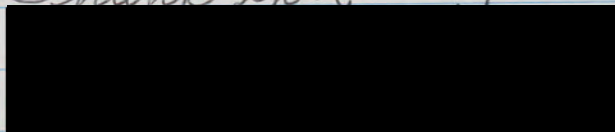
His comment that the people of this country must like kings is as ridiculous as him taking the time to utter the words. Don't know of anything that ever existed on this planet that was worth his first drop of water.
