PRESIDENT'S LIFE PORTRAITS series... there's 1 more.

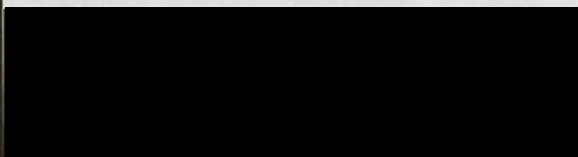
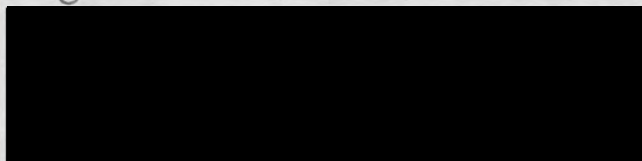
I especially enjoy your moderation of the
