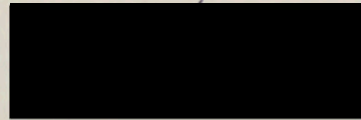
Dear Mr. Lamb:

I have a programming suggestion to offer. Possibly you are aware that the CBC has produced a biography of Pierre Elliot Trudeau. Pierre is a cousin of mine. Our grandfathers on the Elliot side of the family were brothers. His sister Suzette called me from Montreal the day of the earthquake to see if I was affected. While catching up on many things she told me about the film. It was produced in both French and English and was shown in five one hour parts on successive Sunday evenings. She has taped it and I will have an opportunity to see it when she and I vacation in Maine this summer but I would appreciate being able to see it on CSPAN and making my own tape of it. I told Suzette I was going to contact you about the possibilities. She was very interested and asked me to let her know if you show interest in it. She will be in Florida for five weeks beginning Feb. 14th and asked me where she can get a CSPAN schedule. I told her of the sources I am aware of. I depend on channel surfing frequently during the day. I regularly watch

your Monday and Friday a.m. (5 a.m. for me) reporters roundtable and Booknotes on Sunday. Channel surfing led me to discover your coverage of the oath taking by Chrétien and his Cabinet. Chrétien was in Pierre's first Cabinet in the late 60's and he attended Chrétien's oath taking. There were frequent camera shots of him which I appreciated. Suzette was in the states at the time but didn't know you were covering it.

I do hope you will give some thought to contacting the CBC about the availability of the film and will find it feasible for CSPAN to show it.
