Dear Mr Lamb,

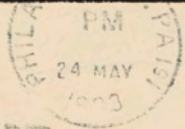

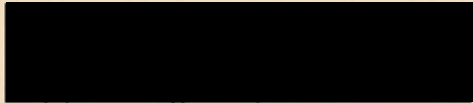
