Republican "duty tricks" Committee.

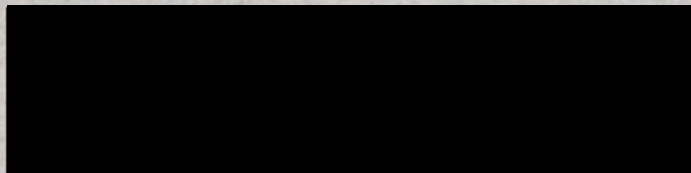
This was mentioned by Lee Atwater
