"AMERICA AND THE COURTS" UPDATE

Washington, D.C., November 13, 1992--Tomorrow, Saturday, November 14, at 7:00-8:00 PM (ET), on C-SPAN's "America and the Courts," journalists, attorneys, and heads of national associations discuss the legal issues of the day.

The program includes a look at a federal judge's order to reinstate a gay sailor; the Supreme Court's refusal to hear a case involving limitations on health insurance benefits by companies that self-insure; the resignation of New York State of Appeals Chief Judge Sol Wachtler; and the National Right to Life's views on abortion rights under a Clinton Administration.
