C-SPAN AIRS HIGHLIGHTS FROM RADIO TALK SHOW HOSTS CONFERENCE

Washington, D.C., June 7 -- C-SPAN will air highlights from the National Association of Radio Talk Show Hosts conference on Saturday, June 16, at 11:00am ET.

Censorship, the "war on drugs," and taxes are just a few of the topics to be tackled at the group's second annual conference in Orlando, Florida.

"Very important subjects will be discussed because radio talk shows have become the voice of America," said Carol Nashe, the conference's organizer.

The group, founded a little more than a year ago by Jerry Williams, a longtime talk show host in Boston, has about 175 members.

C-SPAN is available in almost 50 million households nationwide and around the world via satellite. The network is privately funded and is a public service of the cable television industry.
