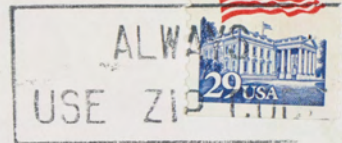
Would you highlight a white man espousing the same hateful message? Of course you would not.
