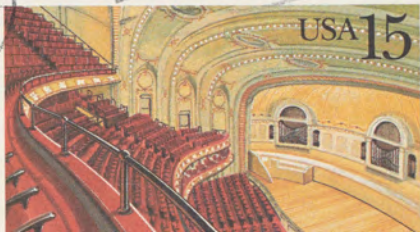
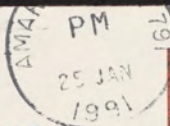
Thank you for giving me a window into Congress. I am encouraging my local cable carrier to implement C-SPAN II as well.
