-- CHEYENNE, WYOMING NEXT STOP ON C-SPAN'S STATE CAPITAL TOUR --

WASHINGTON, D.C.— C-SPAN cable network braves the American frontier to bring cable viewers a closer look at <u>Cheyenne</u>, <u>Wyoming</u> — the next stop on its "States of the Nation '85" tour of state capitals.

On August 15 and 16, C-SPAN will cablecast nearly five hours of viewer call-in programs, conducted <u>live</u> via satellite. Featured guests include <u>Wyoming Gov. Ed Herschler, Cheyenne Mayor</u> Don Erickson, a state legislator, and an Associated Press correspondent. Also, a U.S. Air Force representative and a Cheyenne community activist will appear back-to-back to discuss Cheyenne as the home of an MX missile base.

"Our state capital programming recognizes the importance of public policy decisions being made outside Washington, D.C.," says C-SPAN producer Marilyn Buerkle. "Viewers will be able to talk to Wyoming legislators about the tough issues they face and the national importance of their decisions," she says.

In addition, C-SPAN will show cable viewers Cheyenne in the aftermath of a ravaging storm, as well as the scenic high plains surroundings of the "Cowboy State."
