On November 3rd, 1989, I drove my car from Long Beach city to go to the Slauson Ave. Turn left along the Slauson Ave. Turn right along the Western Ave. Turn left along the Wilshire Blvd. Turn right along the Highland Ave. Turn left along the Sunset Blvd. to go to the Boel Air area.

Meanwhile, a man who drove the red car, drove his car turn left across the red light in front of mine quickly. Suddenly, I knocked his car quickly. Then, he drove his car to park on the corner of the Sunset Blvd., and said to me that,

Why you don't run?
What? (I answered.)

I stopped my car's engine. I came out of my car and went to see everything in front of my car. Suddenly, she and her husband came to ask the driver licence from me.

Do you have the driver licence? (She asked.)

Yes, Madame, I have.

I gave my driver licence to her and him. And I asked her and him to write down her and his driver licence on my paper back.

Write down your driver licence's number on my paper, please!

In the morning on November 7, 1989, I drove my car to go to the Stockton City. From Van Nuys City to go to the Stockton City, was very far. I drove my car during 6 or 7 hours. At 5:00 o'clock AM. I arrived at the Stockton City. At night, I asked the Cambodian Refugee's house to sleep.

In the morning on November 8, 1989, I drove my car to rent an apartment to stay. And I drove my car to go to find the place where my children and his or her mother were living. Meanwhile, I was losing the road. I drove my car to park at the using place near the freeway. Suddenly, I saw an American people came out of his office. I brought the map, and walked to ask him.

Excuse me, Sir, could you tell me, where the Carry Brook Ave. is?
Hmhm! Do you have the map of the Stockton City?
Yes, Sir, I do. Here is the map of the Stockton City.
He took the map from me to look for. And he told me that,
Now, you are here. You have to go on the El Dorado Ave.,
right turn on the Bianchi Road, and right turn on the
Calandria Ave., and the Carry Brook is on that corner.
Thank you for helping me. Goodby, Sir!
Goodby! (He said.)

Then, I drove my car to go to find the Carry Brook Ave,
where the place of my children and my wife were living.
I parked my car by the old man who was working in front
of his house. I went to see him. And I said to him that,

Oh! Good afternoon! Come in. And have a seat, please!

I don't know how to say it." (She answered.) "Could you tell me the name of your school to me to know?" (I asked.) "The name of my school is Harrison. And my room is 22. What is your name?" ([redacted] asked me.) "My name is [redacted]. How do you spell it?"

Oh! The same my last name. (She said.)

Yes, Miss [redacted], The same your last name. But it is difference your name.

Here is my name.

Thank you, Miss [redacted]!

She gave the paper to me. And I said that, "Kin Daddy one, please!" She did follow my words. And I kissed one back to my sister.

Homem! Dear, Gods of the United Nation! Please! Don't make me trouble any more.

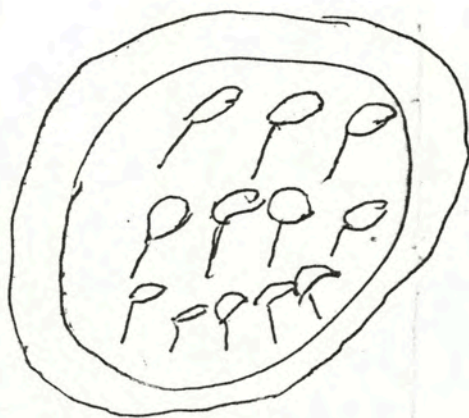
Before I leave from my children, I wish to my children, and I wish to all the people who were living in that house to be a good health.

I heard the bad man, caught the young girl from the Long Beach city, and took that young girl to go to the Fresno to marry.

In the morning on November 26, 1989, I drove my car to find the building of Khmer refugee. At that time, no one came to talk to me yet. Only the driver of the car number _____ and the driver of the car number _____ would like to drive his car to knock me on that Fresno city. At that time, Mr. _____ who live at the number 1104 building in the Long Beach city, came to that Fresno too. And the driver of the car number _____ would like to knock me on that Stockton city too.

I lived at the Stockton city for fews months. I would like to visit some cities on that area. One day, I drove my car to go to the Auburn City. When I came back to the Sacramento city, the two men of the trucks drivers would like to knock my car on the Freeway. Only the truck driver on the left of my car, knocked me a little on the left mirror of my car and went away. Meanwhile, I lost the road, I drove my car through to the 505 Freeway to buy the gas, and I brought the map to ask the Saleslady at the gas station that,

Excuse me, Madame, I was losing the road, could you tell me, where I was, right now?

She took the map from me to look for. And then she said, you were at the Winters area, right now! Where would you like to go? (She asked me.)

I would like to go to the Sacramento City.

O.k. You have to take on the 505 Freeway, and right turn on the 80 Freeway East. You could reach to the Sacramento City on that Freeway.

But, this is the time that I have to leave from my children because I have anything to do next.

was the Cambodian, Laos Translator for Medical General Legal Fields at the Stockton City. He would like me to play music with him. He gave me a hundreds dollars to go to buy a violin to play. I waited him for two weeks. But, he has no plan music for me to play, so I have to say goodbye to him.

I did not have the job to do at the Stockton City. I decided to go to visit some friends of mine who were living at the Santa Rosa City. In the morning on January 31, 1990, I drove my car to go to pumping the gas at the sales gas station. After pumping the gas, I drove my car go on the Hammer Lane to go to get on the 5th North Freeway, and I drove my car go on the 5th North Freeway to go to get on the 12 Freeway. When I arrived at the 12 Freeway, I confused the road. I drove my car to go to park in front of the fruits store on that area. I brought the map with me. I walked into the fruits store. I asked the sales-lady to show me the way that I would like to go. And I said to her that,

Excuse me, Madame, I would like to go to the Fairfield, could you tell me the direction that I would like to go?

She brought the map from me to look for. And she said, would you like to go to the Lodi or where would you like to go? yes, Madame, I would like to go to the Fairfield.

O.k. That is the 12 Freeway. You don't have to go the 12 East Freeway. You have to go to the 12 West Freeway.

Thank you for helping me, Madame, goodbye!

Goodbye! (she said.)
