to have him.

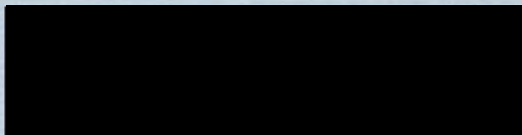
The old "poem"
