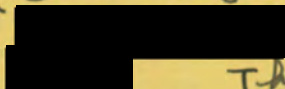

There is one redeeming aspect of this particular rally for those concerned with world overpopulation. Although 300,000 people attended, they will produce few unwanted pregnancies!

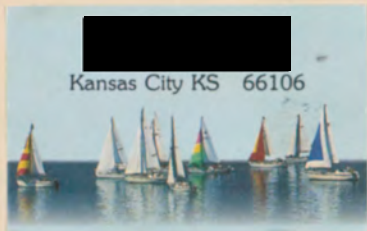
