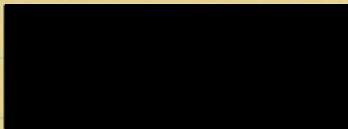

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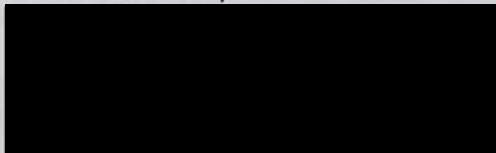

Dear First Lady Hillary:

CONGRATULATIONS!! In your several letters to me you promised we'd win -- and Bill, you, Al and Tipper-- and grass roots America -- did win! It wasn't easy, but together we made it!!

In going over our correspondence, you may recall that you kept asking for more ideas to pass along to the Clinton team. I am enclosing a copy of one measure forwarded to you which now is most likely to meet all three primary objectives of the new Administration -- causing substantive changes in the economy, major reform of our national health care system, and at the same time reduce the Federal deficit.

Such action would produce more than \$104 billion annually. It would take less than \$30 billion annually for the first three years to extend our current MEDICARE system to cover the 37 million unemployed and the 10 million underinsured, leaving \$72 annually for amortizing the Federal deficit.

Simply ask Congress to eliminate the discriminatory cap on Social Security deductions -- now set at \$55,500. The \$104 billion that would result is based upon figures provided by the current administration's General Accounting Office.

I sincerely hope that the Jordan-Christopher Transition Committee recognize the judgment, tact and skills you demonstrated during the past year, and are considering asking you to serve our country as Chief of Staff. I am positive that grass roots America would be delighted.

THE COALITION BOARD OF DIRECTORS APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY--
H.R. 1777

"The mandatory extension of MEDICARE A & B to all ages immediately so that access to adequate medical/hospital care be provided to everyone--this, to be the first step to a universal more comprehensive health care program."

H.R. 1777 can be defined as extending BASIC MEDICARE BENEFITS to persons of all ages, as well as to lawful permanent aliens of the U.S. The program is portable and not tied to employment. In addition to the present Medicare benefits to the elderly, it covers routine physical checkups with special emphasis on preventative care for high risk groups like children and pregnant women.

This extended basic Medicare program can be administered through agencies such as Blue Cross, Blue Shield, HMO's, etc. just as it now does for Senior citizens. All charges for basic Medicare coverages -- whether from doctor hospitals, clinics, pharmacies, equipment suppliers -- can be paid by the Federal Government via our Social Security System at an overhead cost of less than 3%.

TO CUT THE FEDERAL DEFICIT BY 104 BILLION ANNUALLY
AND TO FUND H.R. 1777

We urge your help in removing the disgraceful tax loophole in the 1986 IRS Code which placed a \$53,400 cap on Social Security (FICA) payroll deductions for salaried employees.

THIS CAP IS COSTING OUR TREASURY MORE THAN \$2 BILLION A WEEK...MORE THAN \$104 BILLION ANNUALLY. Eliminating this loophole could fund all programs designed to revitalize our economy and to replace our current wasteful patch-work health care system with a government paid plan extending MEDICARE to persons of all ages...thru H.R. 1777. This will include the 37 million workers now unemployed and uninsured.
