When President Nixon was in the White House he lobbied to get a government contract to sell his computers, and guess who footed the bill, we taxpayers.

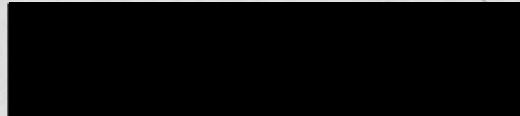
