It seemed to center around what the beliefs of the right wing of politics, with Henry Hyde, William Buckley, Pat Robertson, and a conservative Jewish rabbi.

I. Creation Science came up. It is a national phenomenon but continues to be denied a platform by the news media. UFO's receive a fair hearing. I saw a segment plugging them last night, 9/21/93, with the flimsiest evidence; but the case for creation science by some of the most credible scientific scholars in the world is denied a public hearing by the news media.

Where is there a public forum for this?

I can't think of many things that would be more interesting to your audience. If someone at C-Span would do some creative thinking and assemble some key questions, you would have such an interesting program that your listeners would demand more of the same and various formats. With scarcely a moment's thought I can come up with a variety of areas for questions that would surely be extremely interesting and educational to your audience. From the creation science standpoint:

* Ask for a brief up-date on creation science and the public school... the Supreme Court's rejection of it as religious with Darwinian evolution held to be objective science.

* Ask about the long list of pre-historic men discovered with their models in the top museums in the U.S.

Would it be possible for C-Span to give me an indication of when some such initial program will take place, as I would surely not want to miss it?
