However, I was appalled by the interview Steven Scully had with the Co-Chair of the Republican Party in Little Rock on Road To The White House.

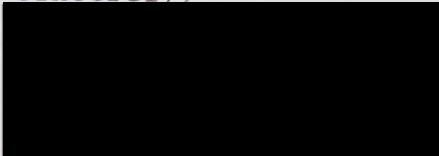
