-- C-SPAN TELEVISES IOWA BUSINESSMEN'S VISIT TO WASHINGTON --

WASHINGTON, D.C.-- When the <u>Greater Des Moines Chamber of Commerce Federation</u> comes to Washington next week, C-SPAN cameras will be trailing them as part of its "States of the Nation '85" programming -- an in-depth look at issues facing state and local governments.

On Monday, <u>July 22 at 8:00 am EDT</u>, C-SPAN begins two days of <u>live cablecasts</u> of the federation's visit. The 50 member bi-partisan group, representing several chambers of commerce from the Des Moines metropolitan area, plans to meet with Congressional leaders and administration officials to discuss economic development concerns facing Iowa.

C-SPAN producer Susan Bundock explains, "Our coverage of the Des Moines federation's trip will focus on its 'grassroots' nature." Bundock adds, "This kind of programming is what C-SPAN does best: we are able to show our viewers, who have not had the opportunity to visit Capitol Hill, 'how things work' in Washington."

C-SPAN also plans to cablecast live roundtable discussions with federation group members and a call-in program with John Hyde who covers Washington for the Des Moines Register.
