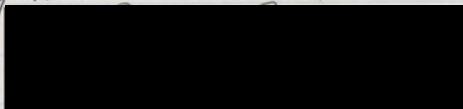

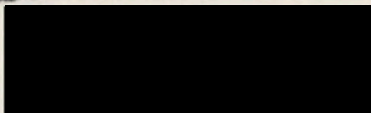
Brock and Cliff Jackson of Little Rock have in common as a motive.
