-- C-SPAN'S "STATES OF THE NATION '85" TRAVELS TO PHOENIX, AZ --

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- C-SPAN cable network plans to showcase Arizona -- everything from 'new' water to Goldwater -- during a weeklong stop in Phoenix as "States of the Nation '85" programming moves into its final weeks.

During this trip, C-SPAN producer Carl Rutan says, "We'll highlight the politics of water, important to this mostly desert state, but we'll also look at a host of timely events and topics in Arizona."

The issues and festivities surrounding the dedication of the Central Arizona Water Project (CAP) will be the centerpiece of C-SPAN's November 11-15 visit to Phoenix. Coverage includes an aerial tour of the entire CAP facility, the "first flow" dedication ceremony with Interior Secretary Donald Hodel and Gov. Bruce Babbitt, and a live telecast of the CAP gala dinner featuring speeches by Gov. Babbitt, Sen. Barry Goldwater, Rep. Mo Udall, and a videotaped message from President Reagan. Arizona policymakers will appear on call-in and interview programs to discuss how the new water supply will be used for statewide growth and how the CAP affects neighboring states.

In addition, C-SPAN plans to televise sessions of the annual Sigma Delta Chi/Society of Professional Journalists convention, including a roast of CBS's Walter Cronkite and a keynote address by Gannett Chairman Allen Neuharth. Political writers and cartoonists from The Arizona Republic and The Phoenix Gazette are featured call-in and interview guests.

C-SPAN celebrates Veteran's Day (November 11) in Phoenix with coverage of the dedication ceremonies of the Arizona Vietnam Veteran's Memorial, being attended by Defense Secretary Caspar Weinberger, former POW Rep. John McCain, and Gen. William Westmoreland.

Other highlights of C-SPAN's Phoenix trip include: a discussion of the sanctuary movement trials in Tucson; a candid interview with retiring Sen. Goldwater that explores his personal side; a roundtable discussion with Arizona business leaders; and a simulcast of a radio call-in show with Sen. Dennis DeConcini.

Nationally, C-SPAN's unique public affairs programming is available in 22 million households via 2,000 cable system affiliates. For the C-SPAN channel number in your area, contact your local cable operator.

Note: C-SPAN's live coverage of the U.S. House of Representatives proceedings may preempt previously scheduled programming. Phoenix programming pre-empted by House coverage will be rescheduled.
