Dear Mr. Lamb,

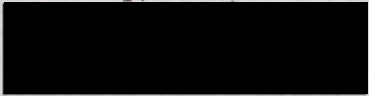
I want to commend one of C-Span's cameramen for his subtle way of handling a situation.
