You must act soon to get our C-SPAN 1 and C-SPAN 2 back on the air!


The "educational" programs you substituted for C-SPAN can more readily be programmed the hours you have now slotted for C-SPAN: from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM. It would be more logical to show C-SPAN live during the daytime hours and the programs we now see, which are all taped anyway, can be shown from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM.

The Huntington Landmark community in Huntington Beach consists of more than 1200 homeowners, many of whom are incensed at having C-SPAN moved to hours we cannot watch or tape.

The "must carry" law is an obvious violation of the 1st Amendment to the Constitution because it makes second-class citizens of public affairs channels like C-SPAN. More than two million homes across the nation have been deprived of the most educational channel ever viewed on television - C-SPAN.

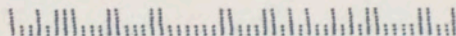
