He would have been ashamed of the name-calling, and applause for anti-white, anti-Jewish and other slandering remarks. Rev. Jesse Jackson learned very little from his actively participating in Rev. King's fight for equality if he could stomach what went on during the meeting of the Black Caucus.

Thank God for C-Span so millions can see the ills that groups like your own spout in the name of justice. Americans of all races and creeds and religions, will not soon forget what they saw at the Cong. Black Caucus meeting.
