What a Network! What a Country!!

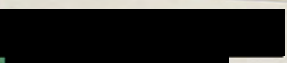
I agree with the lady who confessed to being addicted to C-Span. I am also. And don't bother to bring on the Drug Interdiction Forces. It won't do any good.
