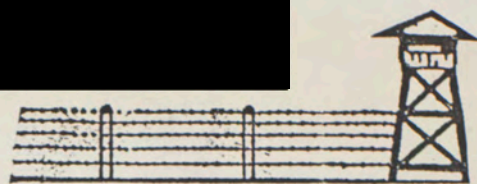

DURING WW II THERE WERE OVER 130,000 PRISONERS OF WAR TAKEN, OF WHICH THE E.T.O. ACCOUNTED FOR OVER 93,000, AS OF JAN 1989 APPROX 58,800 WERE STILL LIVING.

DURING THE MONTHS OF APRIL + MAY 1945 MANY OF THESE PRISONERS OF WAR WERE LIBERATED FROM PRISON CAMPS IN GERMANY. I WAS AMONG APPROX 110,000 ALLIED PRISONERS THAT WERE LIBERATED FROM THE CAMP IN MOOSEBERG GERMANY.

1995 WILL MARK 50 YRS OF OUR LIBERATION.

ANY PLANS TO COMMEMORATE THIS OCCASION
SIMILAR TO THE D-DAY COMMEMORATION.
