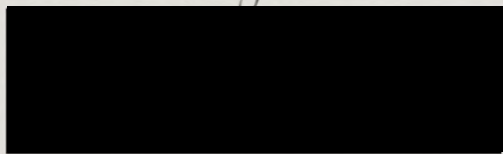

broadcasts.

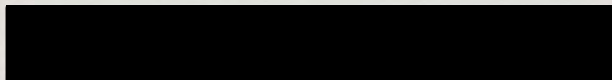
To change the subject, I continue to
