I hope what I am thinking is just not true but if your program continues to show one side of the issue more than the other you are going to lose credit with this viewer and it won't take long!

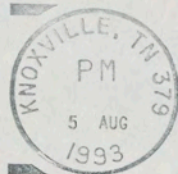
