**"AMERICA AND THE COURTS" EXAMINES LANDMARK CASE ON
PROPERTY RIGHTS AND ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATION
--Meet the Principals in Lucas v. South Carolina Coastal Council--**

Washington, D.C., March 5, 1992 -- C-SPAN looks at the people and issues in the landmark case Lucas v. South Carolina Coastal Council which the U.S. Supreme Court will decide this term.

On Saturday March 7, at 7:00 PM (ET) "America and the Courts" will air interviews with landowner and plaintiff **David Lucas**; Coastal Council director and defendant **Wayne Dean**; and plaintiff's counsel **Camden Lewis**.

In 1986, David H. Lucas paid almost \$1 million for two oceanfront lots to build a summer house on an island off the coast of Charleston, South Carolina. Two years later, the state passed a shoreline protection law that prohibited Mr. Lucas from developing his property. Mr. Lucas argues that the land was "taken" from him, citing a Fifth Amendment clause that provides "nor shall private property *be taken* for public use without just compensation."

If the U.S. Supreme Court rules in favor of the plaintiff, environmental regulation of private lands could be severely limited in the future.

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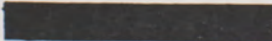

CONCEPT: This is the first of a series of programs on House, Senate and Gubernatorial campaigns happening this year throughout the country. This program on Illinois airs on the eve of the Illinois primary (the primary is Tuesday, March 17). Illinois is losing two seats in the U.S. House of Representatives, and redistricting has created some unusual situations for House members in the Chicago area. We will be looking at a primary campaign in the newly drawn 3rd district of Illinois between two Democratic incumbents, Rep. Marty Russo and Rep. William Lipinski; also a primary race of Rep. Dan Rostenkowski, who's being challenged by former Chicago Alderman Dick Simpson in the new 5th district; and challenges facing Senator Alan Dixon (D-Illinois), who is up for reelection this year.
