We subscribers realize the impact of public services given by the nation's cable companies — but our unhappiness ~~of~~ the changes should be given note.

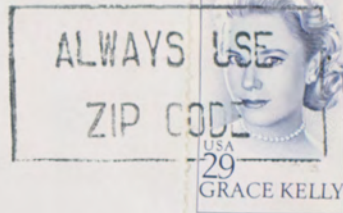
Any future channel changes or offerings we hope will be to our liking.
