This vendetta against the President is completely reprehensible expected only from Republicans, but for them to be aided in their vicious unprincipled attacks is just as unacceptable.

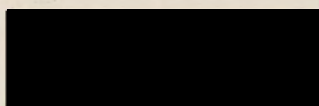
