Dear C-SPAN:

I have watched C-SPAN I and II for many years.

I really enjoy the committee hearings and video call-in programs. I also enjoy the alternative group conferences, different from the statuaquos. My least favorite is foreign visits and interviews with foreign politicians.

This is the first letter I've written to C-SPAN.

I have seen parts of committee hearings on CNN and read articles on committee hearings dealing with AIDS and AIDS legislation. However, I haven't seen much on C-SPAN about these hearings. I haven't seen these hearings carried on C-SPAN daytime or overnight.

Today, September 26, 1991 there was a very interesting and important committee hearing (Waxman) concerning whether or not medical professionals should be required to have mandatory AIDS testing. Kimberly Bergalis and others testified before this committee.

There was a call-in program on that evening about an AIDS report, but I didn't hear when and if this powerful hearing would be shown by C-SPAN.

I watched portions of the hearing shown live on CNN.

I was wondering if C-SPAN I or II plan to ever show this hearing. I'm sure I'm not the only viewer out there who would like to view this hearing.

AIDS is one of the most important issues facing our country. I think Americans need to be informed about this disease and all the consequences surrounding this disease, wherever and whenever possible.

I know no one personally who has the disease; however, I know many Americans are living with this disease. I also know that many Americans are dying with this disease.
