C-SPAN AIRS ARCHITECTURE ADDRESS BY BRITAIN'S PRINCE CHARLES
Critic of Modern British Architecture Speaks In Washington

Washington, D.C., February 21-- Viewers will get a rare chance to hear a full speech by Britain's Prince Charles on Saturday, February 24, at 10:30 pm ET/7:30 pm PT, on C-SPAN, the Cable-Satellite Public Affairs Network.

The Prince of Wales will discuss his new book, A Vision of Britain, at the first annual Accent on Architecture celebration at the National Building Museum in Washington, D.C. The book is critical of modern British architecture, which the prince has said clashes with classical historic structures in London and other British cities.

Prince Charles will also present architecture's highest award, the Gold Medal of the American Institute of Architects, to E. Fay Jones of Arkansas.
