

If it happens on C-SPAN, your listeners will hear about it on C-SPAN'S WEEKLY RADIO JOURNAL.

The program is a balanced, long-form presentation of the weeks events in Washington and around the world as gathered by the Cable Satellite Public Affairs Network. C-SPAN'S WEEKLY RADIO JOURNAL is a natural fit to your station's weekend news and public affairs program line-up, especially in this election year.

Following the opening promotional billboard and segment featuring the views of our television audience, the program gives context to the news stories of the week through longer actualities and an informational script. Newsmakers, policymakers and journalists provide a range of perspectives drawn from C-SPAN's coverage of the House and Senate, speeches, committee hearings, news conferences and other forums inside and outside Washington D.C. .

C-SPAN is the private, non-profit cooperative created by the cable television industry 13 years ago to bring public affairs programming to its national cable television audience.

DISTRIBUTION

Public Stations:

This 59 minute program is available via satellite Channel 11, each Friday evening at 18:00-18:59 ET. Funded through 1993, the program is free to all interconnected stations.

Commercial Stations:

Our program is distributed to commercial stations through the Unistar Radio Networks. Please contact Unistar Affiliate Relations at 800-225-3270.

CARRIAGE RIGHTS

Program must air in its entirety, with the exception of opting out for national or local news at the beginning. The program may air more than once over the course of a weekend. Broadcast is not recommended beyond Monday due to date references.

The program provides a :60 intro, a pause for breakaway, followed by a five minute segment and a clean rejoin at 00:06. Use the window for national or local news.

There are several music bridges within the program to allow for station ID. A full timing run down is provided each week.
