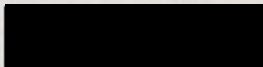


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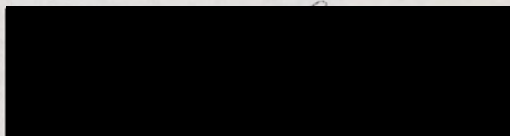

Dear *Mr. Lamb,*

I am enclosing a copy of a letter which I sent yesterday, by Fax, to President George Bush, to persuade him to hold back the bombers, after the midnight "deadline", when Saddam Hussein failed to move out of Kuwait.

There is no reason to believe that President Bush saw my letter, but thought that you might like to read it anyway, since it deals with the likelihood that Saddam Hussein is the Aga Khan, in Kuwait by invitation, and with the even greater probability that if we use force, we shall blow up all of the oil installations in the area, and all of the people there as well, including our own troops.

Dear President Bush,

Please do not do anything hasty in the way of ordering bombers into action in the Persian Gulf, because there is every reason to believe that Saddam Hussein is, in fact, the Aga Khan, leading Moslems into a Holy War against the Emirs in the Gulf region, who have disobeyed Islamic Law, and against ourselves in the West who have supported them.

Senator Daniel Patrick Moynihan said the other evening that we were opposing "the most prominent leader of Islam". The most prominent leader of Islam is the Aga Khan who, as a direct descendant of Mohammed, is not only the religious head of all Islam, but, as "The Sword of Islam", is the enforcer of Islamic Law as well.

All Moslems, from Morocco to Bangladesh and Indonesia, adore and revere him, and will follow him anywhere. Anyone who touches a hair of his head will be subject to the most dire consequences; and good Moslems will be assured of Paradise if they exact a just revenge, should he be harmed.

The Aga Khan used to be accorded his weight in jewels every year, on his birthday. These jewels were extracted chiefly from the rich Maharajas, and were sold, the proceeds being given to the poor: but all Moslems who could contribute anything did so, because that was how much they thought of their Aga Khan; and they still do.

"Saddam", I was told years ago, is a religious title; and all of Saddam Hussein's speeches have been replete with references to God, and with other religious statements.

On December 31, he summoned the Islamic leaders of nearly all of the Moslem countries to a conference in Baghdad, held on Jan. 9 to Jan. 11; and they all came, without demur. The purpose of the Conference was "to draw up a strategy for Islamic action to face aggression". It was attended by over 350 delegates from Jordan, Libya, Yemen, Syria, Pakistan, Sudan, Bangladesh, Egypt, India, Malaysia, Tunisia, Algeria, Turkey, the Soviet Union, Europe and the United States, as well as from Palestinian organizations.



At the conference, Saddam Hussein told the Islamic leaders that he intended to cleanse the Arab nation of corruption, liberate Palestine, and lead a holy war against the United States-led military alliance in the Persian Gulf.

"The New York Times" reported that on Jan. 9 (the day the conference opened), Saddam Hussein addressed 500 delegates of the "Arab Baath Socialist Party" which had helped him to organize and control Iraq for the past 20 years. I therefore conclude that the "Arab Baath Party" and the Islamic leaders of the Moslem world are one and the same.

The inescapable conclusion is that, morally speaking, we are on the wrong side. Senator Alphonse D'Amato said that the list of tortures and other atrocities in Kuwait, compiled by Amnesty International, had been presented at a meeting in the Middle East on May 17, 1990. From this, one must conclude that the atrocities were committed, not by Saddam Hussein, but by the Emir of Kuwait and his court, who have been breaking Islamic laws, and all other laws too. Nor are such infractionations confined to the Emir of Kuwait alone; the other oil Sheiks and Emirs are also included in Saddam Hussein's indictment.

King Fahd of Saudi Arabia, and the Emirs of the Gulf States, have been reported to fear Saddam Hussein more than they fear a United States occupation, and probably with good reason. In his New Year's Eve message, Saddam Hussein said that King Fahd was a traitor to Islam, and he accused you of "supporting the forces of evil".

The Emirs have broken Islamic Law in the following ways:

- 1) They have been using the wealth derived from oil for their own benefit, instead of sharing it with all Moslems. They have not paid their "Poor Tax", and have not given 1/40 to 1/10 of their total wealth to the poor each year.
- 2) Islamic law forbids gambling even more stringently than it forbids liquor. The Emirs have been photographed gambling on the stock exchanges around the world, and may have patronized casinos as well.
- 3) Islamic law - and criminal law too - forbid Usury; i.e. the lending of money at interest, since this leads to inflation and the subsequent devaluation of everybody's currency. The Emirs have been doing business all over the world, and "investing" their money, thereby committing usury.
- 4) They have sent their money abroad, which is forbidden, since this takes money away from the Moslem fraternity.
- 5) Islamic Law respects the rights of women, and accords them equality. The Emir of Kuwait is reported to have had 40 wives and 70 children. Since he is allowed to have only 4 wives at a time, he has been divorcing some to marry others, against the law.
- 6) The Emir and his court have also been reported to have patronized brothels and strip-tease parlors in London and elsewhere. It



must be assumed that he has accorded the same privileges to visiting firemen in his own country, since Saddam Hussein, on August 11, told his followers to "Revolt against the oil emirs who accept to push the Arab women into whoredom".

- 7) The list of atrocities compiled by Amnesty International suggests that boys, as well as women, have been "pushed into whoredom", tortured and mutilated by the same "oil emirs".

Any executions which may have been carried out on orders from Saddam Hussein, since he entered Kuwait to clean out the Augean Stables, have probably been done in retribution for such crimes; for Islam believes in "an eye for an eye". Not only the Emirs, but all of their followers and supporters, have very likely been involved.

- 8) Islamic Law insists on equal recognition being given to other religions; so that when our servicemen and women are forbidden to celebrate their religious holidays and services, or to wear religious medals, that is an infraction of law.

The given name of the present Aga Khan is Karim Al Hussaini Shah. I have heard Saddam Hussein called "Karim", and "Hussein" fits "Hussaini". He was educated at Harvard, and from observing his television interviews, it is clear that he understands English perfectly well.

He is always treated with immense respect by other Islamic leaders, while his followers kiss his hand and cheer him loudly. He wears a uniform with a crown on the epaulets; and under the crown is a pair of wings with crossed swords between them. I believe that the wings represent the Phoenix, symbolizing Islam; while the swords connote his position as the Sword of Islam.

Saddam Hussein has reputedly stated that he will not withdraw from Kuwait until he has spoken to you personally, by telephone. It is curious that while you have spoken to nearly all of the other leaders of the world (23 phone calls to 12 leaders in 5 days, by one account), you have never called Saddam Hussein himself, to ask what he is doing in Kuwait, what he wants, or whether he has a right to be there. I believe you will find that was invited to be there, by the legitimate Government of Kuwait, in the person of King Saud, now acting as the Ambassador from Kuwait to the United States.

I would urge you to call Saddam Hussein as soon as possible, and so avert the catastrophe of a devastating and unnecessary war. Naturally, you should not take my word for all of this, but should ascertain for yourself whether or not these things are true.

As stated in my letter of Sept. 27 to Congressman S. William Green, I believe that our troops in Arabia were actually ordered there by Queen Elizabeth II - in her capacity of Supreme Commander of all land and naval forces in the world - so that we could bring them back, and so start to live by the rule of law - our Constitution -, and be seen to do so. I am currently writing to you at length on this subject;



but am sending this letter in the meantime, since to stop the war is an emergency.

In an area as thick with oil wells, oil pipes, oil fields and other oil installations as the Persian Gulf is, even one untimely bomb dropped, might well set off a conflagration which would engulf the whole region in flames and smoke.

Experts testified at the House and Senate Armed Services Committee hearings, that Kuwait alone has 1000 oil wells, which, if set on fire, would burn for one or two years, and might well result in over a billion deaths: from fire, or asphyxiation from smoke, or subsequent air pollution caused by toxic petroleum fumes, which would spread for thousands of miles and cut off everybody's oxygen. No other chemical weapons could possibly be necessary.

The experts also estimated that the temperatures in Saudi Arabia and the Gulf States would rise to 500°; so that obviously all of the oil in the area - Iraqi, Kuwaiti and Saudi - would be totally destroyed, as well as all the people.

Saddam Hussein knows this, and is prepared to be a martyr; and so does General Schwarzkop, who said that unless sanctions were continued, he would be dead. King Hussein of Jordan said that armed conflict would result in "widespread devastation from which it will take generations to recover"; while General Colin Powell said armed force would cause "carnage" which would lead to "shock and revulsion" in America, to the extent that we should not want to use such armed force again "for decades".

Perhaps you have heard that the novelist Salman Rushdie had a price placed on his head for supposedly making fun of Mohammed. If we are responsible for the death of Mohammed's direct descendant, the Aga Khan, no American will be safe for generations from Moslem revenge and terrorism, at home or abroad. If you let the Aga Khan be "boiled in oil" - an ancient Arabian punishment - you may confidently expect to meet the same fate yourself; and I certainly do not wish this on either of you.

So please call Saddam Hussein now, and stop the madness before it goes any further, and before all of our troops, as well as all of his, get killed in one horrendous Holocaust.
