-- C-SPAN TELEVISES GOVERNORS' WASHINGTON MEETING --

-- Cable Network's NGA Winter Meeting Coverage Begins February 21 --

WASHINGTON, D.C.— 1987 marks the fifth consecutive year <u>C-SPAN</u> cable network has provided its nationwide audience with an insider's look at the <u>National</u> <u>Governors' Association (NGA) winter meetings</u>. C-SPAN plans <u>25 hours of first-run</u> <u>telecasts</u> — many of them <u>live</u> — from the NGA's 1987 winter conference in Washington, D.C., February 21-24.

C-SPAN's four-day coverage begins on <u>Saturday</u>, <u>February 21 at 1:00 pm EST</u> with a live cablecast of the NGA's opening news conference. The theme of this year's meeting is "Making America Work: Productive People, Productive Policies." While the issues of competitiveness and welfare reform serve as the centerpiece of this NGA gathering, topics such as education, agriculture, international trade, and foreign relations are also on the agenda for the states' chief executives.

C-SPAN plans to supplement its coverage of the NGA work sessions with <u>live</u> viewer call-in programs from the conference site. More than a dozen governors are expected to talk with C-SPAN viewers about the various public policy issues facing the nation, during thirty-minute call-in shows.
