VIRGINIA GUBERNATORIAL DEBATE AIRS NATIONALLY ON C-SPAN

Washington, D.C., October 6 -- C-SPAN will air live the first debate between Virginia gubernatorial candidates Marshall Coleman and Douglas Wilder on **Monday, October 9, at 8pm ET.**

The debate, sponsored by the League of Women Voters, pits Coleman (R), state attorney general from 1978 to 1982, against Lt. Governor Douglas Wilder (D). If he wins, Wilder would be the first black elected governor in the nation. The general election is on Tuesday, November 7.

WXEX-TV of Petersburg, Virginia is providing camera and audio equipment for the live telecast. C-SPAN, in addition to airing the debate across the country and around the world, will beam the signal via satellite to ABC network affiliates in Virginia and Washington, D.C. so they can also air the debate live.

C-SPAN will re-air the debate in its entirety Monday night at 11pm ET.
