MISSISSIPPI CONGRESSIONAL CANDIDATES' DEBATE ON C-SPAN

C-SPAN will air a debate between candidates for Mississippi's 5th Congressional District on **Sunday, October 1, at 7pm ET/6pm CT.**

State Attorney General Mike Moore (D), State Senator Gene Taylor (D), and former U.S. Ambassador Tom Anderson, Jr (R) are vying for the seat left vacant by the death in August of Rep. Larkin Smith.

The one-hour debate, sponsored by WLOX-TV in Biloxi, took place on Wednesday, October 27. The special election is on Tuesday, October 3.
