I watch C-Span every day. Thank for informing the American people the way they should be informed.

What is your procedure for providing tapes of programs that are broadcast?

About two years ago Secretary of the Interior, Bruce Babbitt, made a speech, I believe it was in California. At that time he was the President of the League of Conservation Voters. The speech was about scarce water resources in southern California. In the speech he spoke at length about the Bureau of Reclamation and reclamation projects in the West.

On December 10, 1993, the Department of Interior, Assistant Secretary George Frampton, and Katy McGinty, of the President's Office of the Environment, announced at a press conference, that the Department is going to implement new Endangered Species policies in the Pacific Northwest, particularly on lands occupied by, or containing habitat for, the northern spotted owl. On December 11, 1993, I believe that was the date, C-Span aired the press conference. Frampton spoke at length on the new policies and how they would be implemented.
