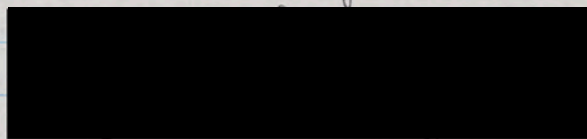


all over again, where the facts are ignored, and the issue shifted to blaming Star and process.
