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Dear Mr. Lamb:

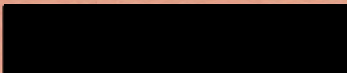
I am writing this in outrage to your recent programming especially in regard to the "Media and the White House".

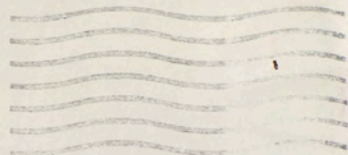
