of the year.

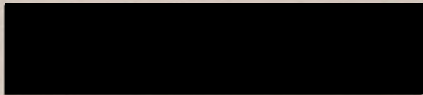
I note you have pre-

Brian Lamb kept bringing up news headlines critical of the current administration with his news media guests last week.

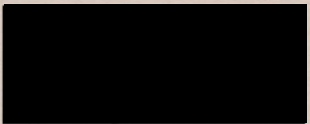
When a moderate is interviewed, he is peppered with questions of a negative nature whereas the "other side" is rarely asked about his views in this way.
